When Operational GSICS products become available

Do we want to keep them for other users to access at a later date (and not from a GSICS collaboration servers)?

- Why do you want to keep the products?
 - Is there a continuing user community for the GSICS products as storage of products has a cost so a justification is needed to qualify this expense.
- How long do you want to keep the products?
 - Maintenance of products is even more of a cost so a justification is needed to qualify this expense.
- Who can access the products?
 - Costs are also incurred for both online and media delivery.



A formal request to Archive with justification from the GRWG to the GDWG at least 2 months or at the start of the pre-operational phase (which ever is the earlier).

GDWG to discuss the request and make a recommendation on the request. This can be done via tools googlegroup mail, Doodle or WebEx teleconference (if discussion is needed).

Disagreements should be resolved by the Executive Panel.





- The GRWG requests the archiving of EUMETSAT GEO-LEO-IR products because the calibration values are needed by the user community for processing of all MSG15 data sets from the EUMETSAT Data Centre.
- The GDWG makes a recommendation to the request based on:
 - Accepting the justification.
 - A GPRC volunteers to archive the data, supports its maintenance and distribution to the user community.
- If the recommendation is positive then an estimate when the products can be archived should be provided by the GDWG.
- If the recommendation is negative then the GRWG can appeal to the executive panel.



Lets Continue to Achieve Results !

- GSICS achievements have been through International Partners working together.
- We need to continue this through a sense of urgency to commit to <u>common agreed goals</u>.
- Taking a lead to develop a common agreed goal does not mean you are totally responsible for work.
- Seeking support is expected through the gsics-dev googlegroups mailing list or a dedicated WebEx teleconference.
- Just to re-literate <u>GSICS achievements</u> are a <u>Result of</u> <u>International Partners working together</u>!
